Decoding Crisis

How crisis is constructed reveals analytical and political parti pris. Crisis narratives shape crisis politics. The 2008 crisis is a crisis of financialization and deregulation, both expressions of 'free market' capitalism, in combination with mounting trade and current account deficits and debt in the US and sovereign debt in part of the Euro zone. While it doesn't bring about significant power changes in the US it does signal a wider trend of global rebalancing from the North to the global East and South.
